Happenings in our Specials

Science/Art

January:

4's

This month in Art/Science we will learn about Sculptor, Alexander Calder. We used his stabile technique to make our artwork really POP! We experimented with static electricity and then created a piece of art using the balloons we experimented with. Using the idea of stretch from The Mitten by Jan Brett, we will see what materials stretch and which do not. Then, we will create a piece of art using rubber bands! Lastly, we will study a little forensic science by using fingerprints to find out who stole the cookie from the cookie jar.

3's

This month in Art/Science we will also learn about sculptor, Alexander Calder. We will use his technique of balance to create a mobile. We experimented with static and made firework art to celebrate the new year. After learning about how animals use camouflage in the wild, we created a polar bear using forks instead of paint brushes. We will learn the importance of fish scales and will create a piece of art accentuating the scales by using celery to create our scale patterns. Lastly we will mix primary colors to make new colors (secondary).

<u>February:</u>

4's

We will start the month learning about the Chinese New Year and crate a piece of dragon art! Then we will use shapes to write a coded message. Lastly, we will begin our study of artist, Alma Thomas by making cool and warm color art.

3's

This month in the 3's we will crate artwork to celebrate winter! First, we will celebrate the Year of the Dragon when we learn about the Chinese New Year. Then, we will see what happens when we freeze paint, build a home for a penguin, and work on a snowy day collage.

Music

January: All ages...

We are using movement, activities and games to enhance our songs about snow and cold weather animals!

February:

The 2's classes will use rubber duckies to add some fun and movement to bird, duck, bubble, bath time and lovey songs.

The 3's and 4's classes will be singing about pet love and friendship this month. We will use matching, counting, sharing, and movement to enrich songs.

Creative Movement

January:

The children are focusing on Tossing and Catching this month with Miss Brook & Miss Katie

February:

They will be enjoying activities that focus on Balance.

Intro to Dance program

The children who are participating in this afterschool program are learning different aspects of dance.
